



PSW Student Aide

Role Description

The PSW Student Aide is part of the inter-professional healthcare team that works collaboratively and safely to support care and in-service within the Long-Term Care home by providing personal care to residents as a member of the LTC staff team, and other service providers to ensure programs meet the physical, social, emotional and spiritual needs of the residents, with an emphasis on resident safety and engagement.

Duties

The PSW Student Aide is responsible, under the direct or indirect supervision of a PSW, for engaging with residents and providing social stimulation interactions through personal care activities for residents, including: Supporting the resident with connecting with family and friends via technology; Providing dining room and feeding assistance to residents during mealtime in collaboration with food service staff; Assisting staff with lifts and transfers; Providing basic food preparation as required and supporting with basic housekeeping and laundry functions at the Home.

In collaboration with Algonquin College, North Renfrew Long-Term Care Services Inc. located in Deep River is seeking applications for the PSW Student Aide (PSA) position from students nearing completion of the PSW Program. The PSA Job-out Program provides students with the opportunity to complete the required practicum hours for the PSW program as a temporary employee of North Renfrew Long-Term Care Services Inc.

PSW Student Aide Position:

Under the direction and supervision of the Manager of Resident Services, the PSW Student Aide provides assistance to regular nursing and other staff to provide resident-focused personal care, with an interdisciplinary team consistent with NRLTCSI's Mission, Vision and Values.

Qualifications:

- PSW Student.
- Former Health Care Aide or Other related experience/skills.
- Experience in a Long-Term Care setting considered an asset.
- Ability to work well with others in a team approach, and adapt to changing situations.
- Ability to meet, and maintain health requirement standards as per Long-Term Care Legislation.
- Physically capable of performing assigned duties within a flexible work schedule in a 24/7 environment.

Compensation: \$16.75 per hour plus 10% in lieu of vacation and benefits
